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Key Messages

Statistical Year Ending - (08/09) February 2009

General

Overall the performance for **Children Looked After** for Southwark as at the end of February 09 is strong and improving

Particular Successful

% Care Leavers with 5+ GCSEs: has typically shown improvement over the years and is currently at 17.3% end Feb 09, exceeding its 07/08 Target and SN average of 13% and 12.2% respectively

Number of CLA per 10,000 population aged under 18: has remained steady within 549 and 554 since Q2 08/09 and currently we have 552 Children Looked After; a 101.2 per 10,000 under 18 population rate (Indicator 14), well within our Target of 101.

Timeliness of Placement: has shown improvement since it's drop to 89% in Q2 and currently stands at 92.6% ending January 2009.

Long Term Stability of Placement of CLA: has shown improvement since its drop to 63.7% in 08/09 Q1 and is currently at 68.3% (end 08/09 Q3)

CLA Placed outside 20 miles radius of their home address: This has been below it's target of 8% throughout the financial year and is currently at 4.8%

Number of CLA Adoptions & SGOs: There was a total of 44 adoptions in the whole of 2007/08; a 10.1% rate of all CLA for more than one year, which was above the statistical neighbour average of 9.5% and we currently have 45 adoptions and special guardianship orders (SGOs) Year To Date (April 08 – Jan 09)

% CLA adopted from Looked After Care: has shown improvement over the year and with a current figure of 7.2% end 08/09 Quarter 3; expected to therefore exceed it's target of 7.5% at year end.

Areas of Concern

Care Leavers in EET: A great increase in the number of care leavers reaching 19 (from April 1st to Date) compared with the slower trend of CLA in EET, hence the drop from 07/08 outturn of 67.5% to 48.1%. Target is 68%. However, we know that there is a major national down turn in employment.

Care Leavers in Suitable Accommodation: Again the number of CLA in suitable accommodation does not match up with the number of care leavers reaching 19 (from April 1st to Date). Drop from 91.6% in 07/08 outturn to 75.3%. 07/08 SN is 91.1%

Ones to Watch

CLA Placed within 7 miles radius of their home address: This has been steady at 64% since November 08 and there is therefore great concern as 07/08 Target was 70%

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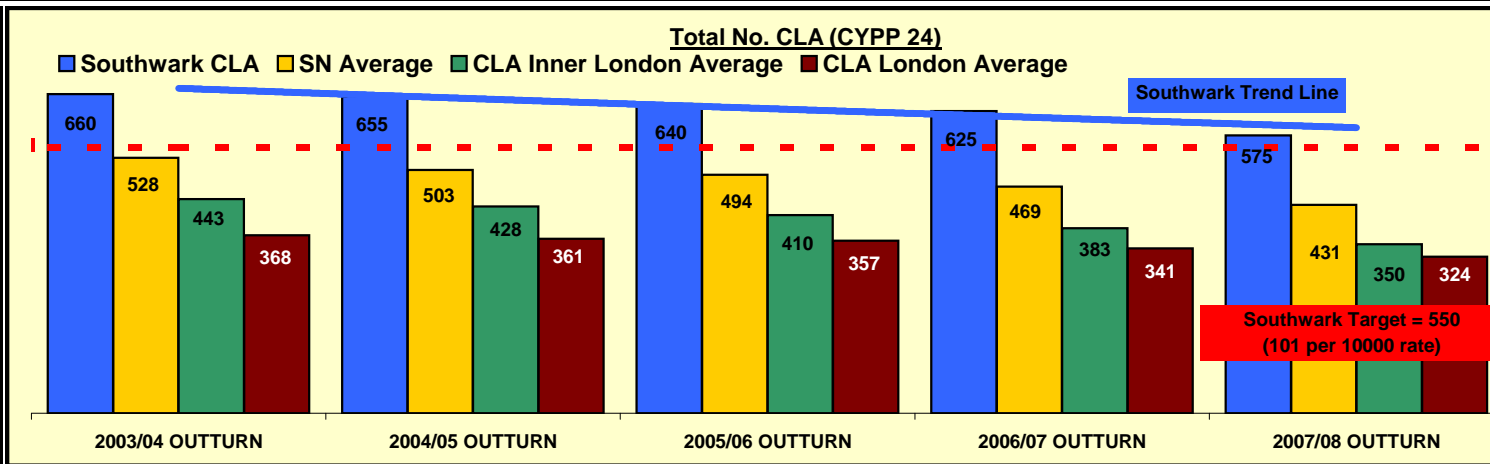
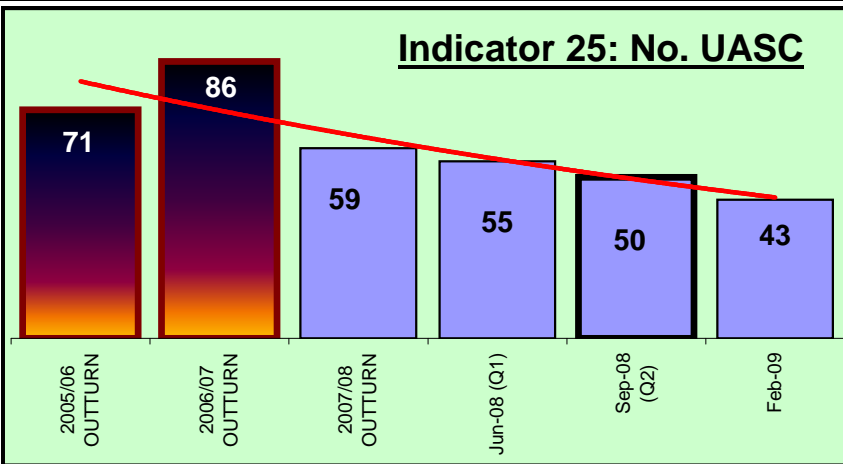

Although this PI has shown great improvement from previous years down from 660 in 2003/04 outturn, however the rate still stands high compared to it's SN of 87

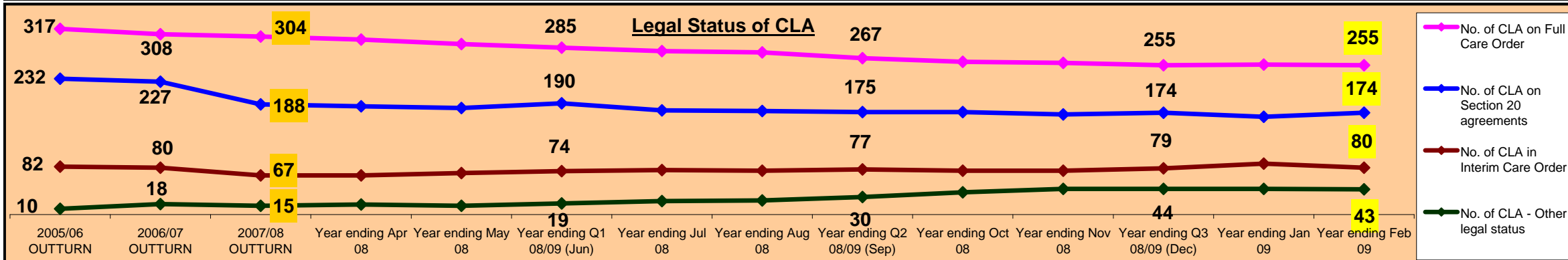
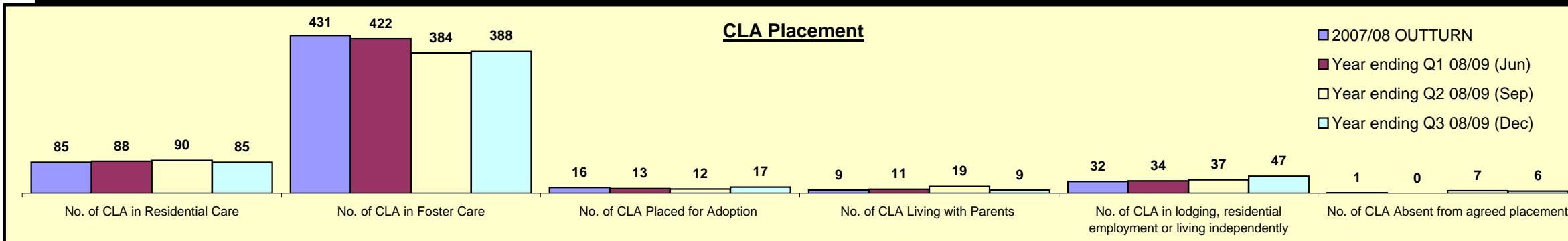
This PI has improved steadily from 19 end Q2 to 17 in October to 9 in Q3 08/09. Currently **13** end Feb 09.

No. of CLA Placed for Adoption Indicator 4

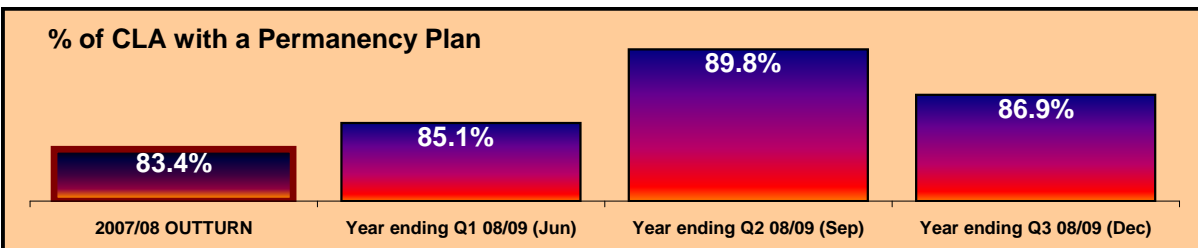
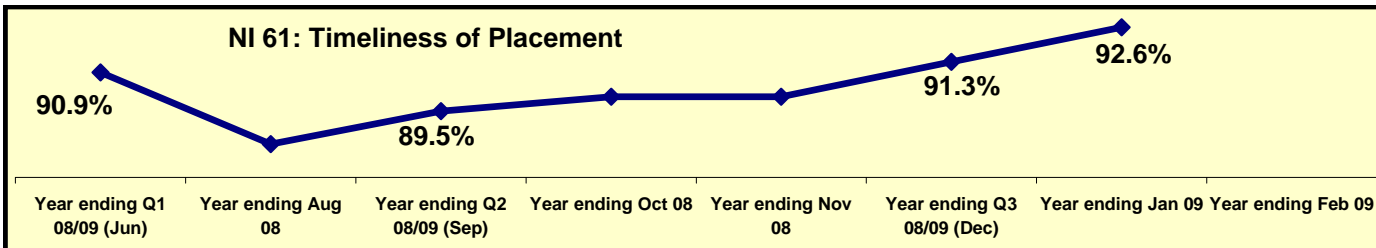

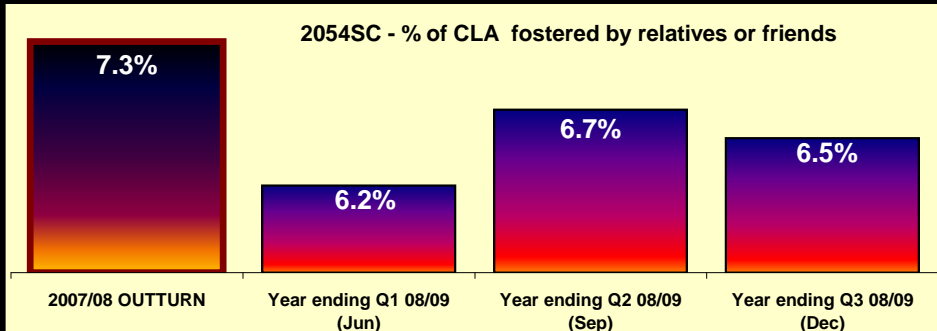
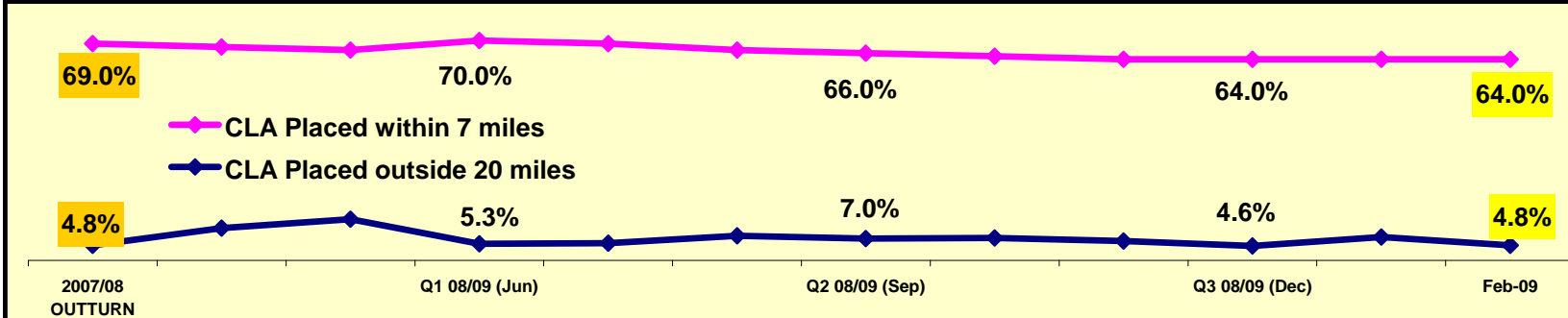
This PI shows improvement from Q2 (16.4%) to **15.7%**; a better performance than its SN at 16.8%.

2054SC & 2068SC (Indicator 16 & 17):
Of the 554 current CLA, 38 are staying with a Relative/Friend (6.9%) end Jan09; improvement in performance from drop in Oct 08. The % of CLA aged 10 to 15 in foster placements/adoption (Indicator 17) dropped from 85.7% 07/08 outturn to 82.5% in Q2 but has been increasing steadily and is currently 85.6%; it has been typically better than it's SN of 83% throughout the year.

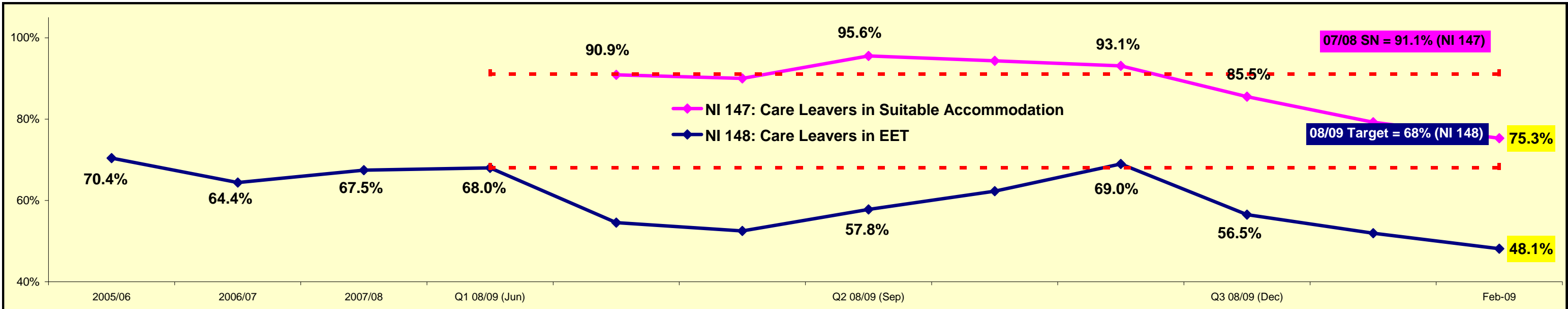

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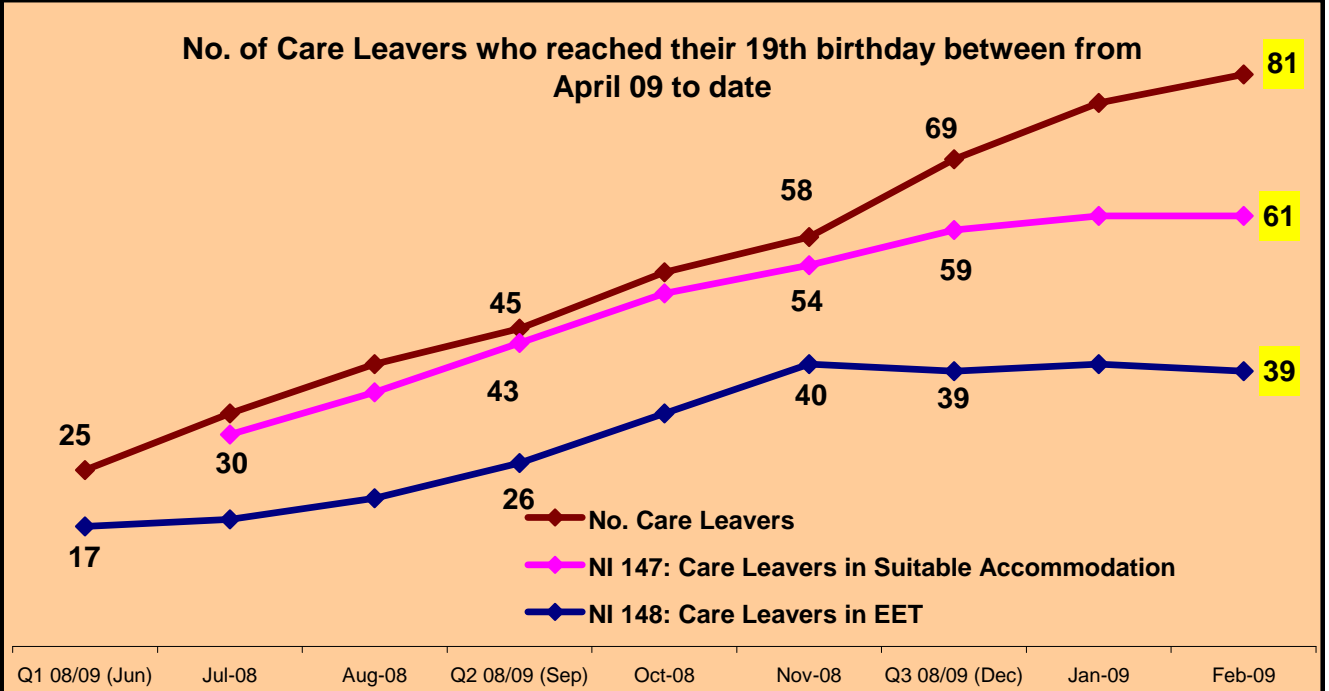

Care Leavers in EET (National Indicator 148) Indicator 28
 Although there has been a more aggressive increase in the trend of Care Leavers reaching their 19th birthday (between April 1st 2008 to date) since November 2008, this is not being matched in increase of the numbers in Education, Employment or Training, therefore the drop in performance of this Indicator. This has dropped from 69.0% (40 in EET of 58 Care Leavers) in November 2008 to currently **48.1%** (39 in EET of 81 care leavers) end Feb 09.

Care Leavers in EET Ratio against Population in EET (5022SC) Indicator 27
 Due to this, we are also below the (improved) Southwark population of the same age group in EET, published for 2007 at 77.71% - a ratio of 0.62

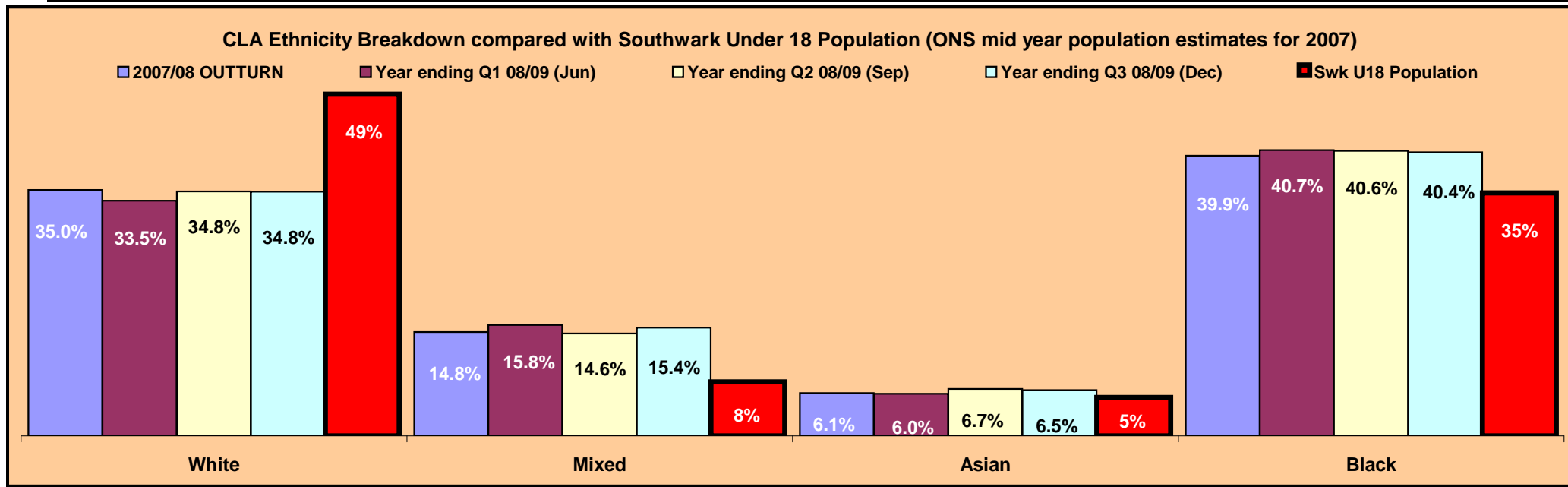
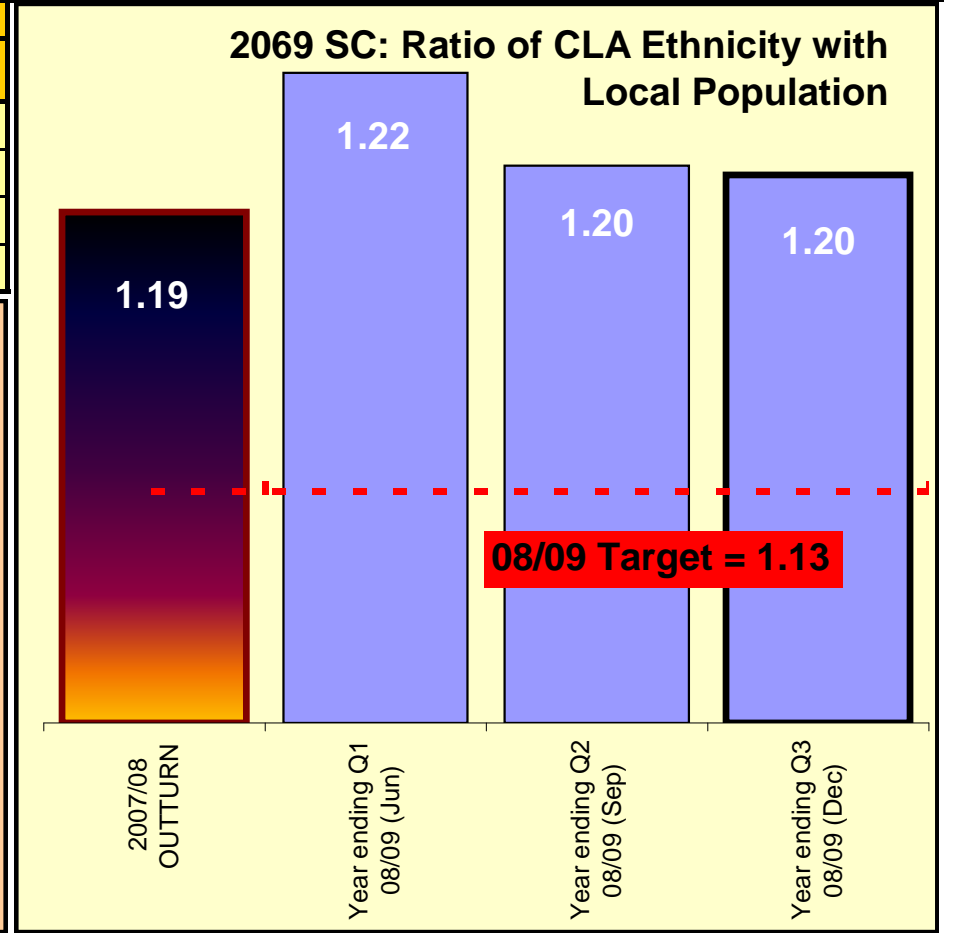
Care Leavers in Suitable Accommodation (National Indicator 147) Indicator 29
 Again the number of care leavers in suitable accommodation has not matched the increase in the number of Care leavers reaching their 19th birthday (between April 1st 2008 to date), thus this indicator has also seen a drop and it is currently at 75.3% (61 in suitable accommodation of 81 care leavers) from it's financial year high of 95.6% (43 in suitable accommodation of 45 care leavers) in 08/09 Q2.

Long Term Stability of Placement of CLA of the 180 under 16 year olds looked after for 2-1/2yrs, there were 123 living in the same accommodation for 2 years plus (68.3%) ending Q3; slightly below in performance of the Target (70%)

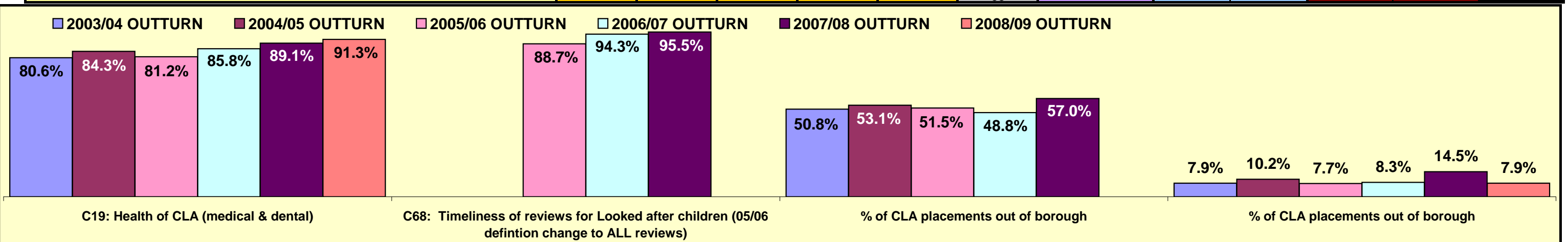
