Of the 549 current CLA, 34 are staying with a Relative/Friend (6.2%); steady from last month's performance. Performance has not been very GOOD throughout the year as compared with its SN of 9.8%. However **% of CLA aged 10 to 15 in foster placements/adoption** (Indicator 47) dropped from 85.7% 07/08 outturn to 82.5% in Q2 but has been increasing steadily and is currently **84.6%**; it has been typically better than its **SN of 83%** throughout the year.

The % of CLA adopted from LA care (Indicator 50) is currently **10.0%** which is better than **SN = 9.5%**.
