ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Outcome of Briefing Sessions

2. Appendix 1a is a new addition to those previously provided in the original report item which has been circulated and published. Appendix 1a provides summary information and assessments of Members / Community preferred schemes for 2013/14 following the briefing sessions requested by the community council Chair last week.

Clarifications of Budgets

3. It is noted that in previous years, the then Borough and Bankside Community Council agreed to informally divide the funding between wards equally and the information below is provided on that basis, however formally, the funding for 13/14 and any underspends rolled forward as detailed below are allocated to the Community Council as a whole.
4. Borough & Bankside Community **Chaucer ward** - 2011/12 and 2012/13 financial years.

For the financial years 2011/12 and 2012/13, during the then Borough & Bankside Community Council, Chaucer ward deferred using its under spends and allocations as follows:
