

PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN ISLAND – BURBAGE ROAD

Following a request from the Dulwich Society to introduce a pedestrian refuge island at the junction of Burbage Road with Gallery Road, the Dulwich Community Council has awarded Cleaner Greener Safer funding to implement such an island, subject to hearing the views of local people.

The main scheme elements include:

- Introduction of a new pedestrian refuge island located on the existing raised carriageway table in Burbage Road (adjacent to roundabout);
- Whilst car traffic can still turn left into Burbage Road from Gallery Road, larger vehicles will have to traverse around the roundabout to access Burbage Road:
- Introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions both sides of Burbage Road to ensure adequate sightlines are maintained to the crossing location and the carriageway is free from obstruction;
- Bollards are to be installed on the island to provide additional protection to pedestrians waiting within the extents of the island;
- A bell bollard is to be installed on the southern corner of the junction to ensure vehicles do not overrun the footway.

On the reverse of this letter is a plan illustrating the above proposals. We would be grateful if you could take the time to answer the questionnaire included in the consultation pack and return it using the pre-paid envelope provided by **Friday 20**th **December 2013.** Your response will be important in understanding whether there is a public demand for the provision of this additional facility.


