5. A deputation request has been received from a group of students in Southwark on the government's withdrawal of the educational maintenance allowance, a motion on the same subject can be found elsewhere on this agenda (see item 9.1)

6. A deputation request has been received from a two local businesses in respect of the motion 'Southwark Tribute to Heroes, which can be found elsewhere on this agenda. The deputation states:

> "We would like to explain the work which we do in the community to support Help for Heroes and Homes for Heroes. We would also like to explain the process by which armed forces killed in action make their last journey from Southwark and why we support the suggestion that Southwark Council should recognise this and pay formal tribute."
