Areas have been identified where parking arrangements can be amended to improve parking conditions for residents, these are listed below and shown on the plan overleaf.

# Proposal B

The introduction of a permit holder (zone L) parking bay.

# Proposal C

Reduce the width of the parking bays from 2.0m to 1.8m to ensure vehicular access is maintained at all times.

# Proposal D

Extend the existing parking place by 5.0m, creating an additional parking space.

# **Evesham Walk / Love Walk** South Camberwell (L) Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ)

# Dear resident, business owner/occupier,

Southwark Council is committed to effective on-street parking for residents, businesses and visitors to the borough.

# **Background**

When the South Camberwell (L) Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) was introduced in 1999, Evesham Walk was not included, despite being public highway and within the boundary of the zone.

Within a CPZ, it is required that all lengths of the carriageway be marked with either a yellow line or a parking bay.

At present, Evesham Walk has a free parking arrangement, this may encourage displaced parking, causing obstructive and reduced parking capacity for residents and their visitors.

The introduction of permit holders parking should reduce parking pressure that currently exists in Evesham Walk.

Additionally, in Love Walk, three parking spaces are not designated for permit holders which causes difficulty for local residents.

# What are we consulting upon?

# **Evesham Walk (Proposal A)**

In view of Evesham Walk's cul-de-sac layout we are currently seeking special sign type approval from the Department for Transport (DfT) to implement controls that differ from a standard CPZ.

It is proposed that a sign will be placed close to the entrance of Evesham Walk (see enclosed design). Any vehicle parking beyond this point will be required to display a valid South Camberwell (L) parking permit during the operational hours (8.30am – 6.30pm, Monday to Friday).

There will be no parking bays or yellow lines marked within Evesham Walk. There will be one sign, situated at Evesham Walk junction with Love Walk, to indicate that beyond that point vehicles are required to display a permit to park.


This proposal only applies to the area highlighted on the plan overleaf and not private off-street driveways or the garages forecourt.



The Hamlet

The proposed parking scheme in Evesham Walk will be identical to a scheme very successfully introduced in The Hamlet, which also falls within the South Camberwell (L) CPZ. This was introduced in March 2009. Signs were installed at the entrance of The Hamlet giving a minimum-impact upon the amenity of the cul-desac.
