"A resident said that a premises on Great Dover Street / Spurgeon Street was being coverted into a budget hotel and that a two- storey extension at the back of the Morleys takeaway was being built. The chair asked officers to look into those two cases."	Officers have checked the planning applications system for the past five years in Spurgeon Street and Great Dover Street and could not find any reference to a permission for a new hotel. However, a breach of planning control is being investigated for a hotel/hostel at 1-20 Spurgeon Street and 58 Great Dover Street (11-EN-0214). The Enforcement Officer will be contacting the complainant for more information, as there is no evidence that a hotel use is being carried out there currently. In respect to Morleys, permission was granted on 21 September 2010 (09-AP-0537) for a first and second floor rear extension to comprise 2 studio flats with re-routed extract duct up side of building. There was a complaint that it was not authorised, but this was found not to be the case: the extension was being built in accordance with the approved drawings.
