Plans to ensure the safety of the public and prevention of crime and disorder in regards to the application for a Temporary Event Notice

Date of event: 2^h July 2009 – 5th July 2009

Location of event: Level 10, Peckham Rye Car Park □ Rye Lane, SE15

A) Police Access and egress from Premises

During opening hours all entrances and exits to and from the premises will be unlocked allowing access for police and other similar bodies if required. These entrances and exits will only be locked when the premises is not open to the public, and the designated premises supervisor has made a thorough inspection of the premises to ensure no member of the public remains on site.

B) Maps of local area and plan of venue to be used

Please see the attachment received with this document for said plans.

The extent of the venue to be used is the café area of the car park, as shown by the red perimeter labeled "café extents" in the plans

C) Monitoring and control of numbers of visitors to the premises

For this event we expect no more than 50 visitors at any one time. If there are visibly more than 50 people on the premises new visitors will be prevented from entering by a member of staff.

D) Evacuation, first aid and emergency procedures.

In case of an emergency there are two staircases directly from level 10 to the ground floor on the eastern and western side of the building. An additional staircase is provided on level 9 directly onto the Ground level. Wheelchair users can use ramps from level 10 to the Ground floor.

The following emergency procedures will be in place prior to the start date of Franks Café and Campari Bar:

- A clear plan highlighting emergency exits will be prominently displayed visible from any place in the premises

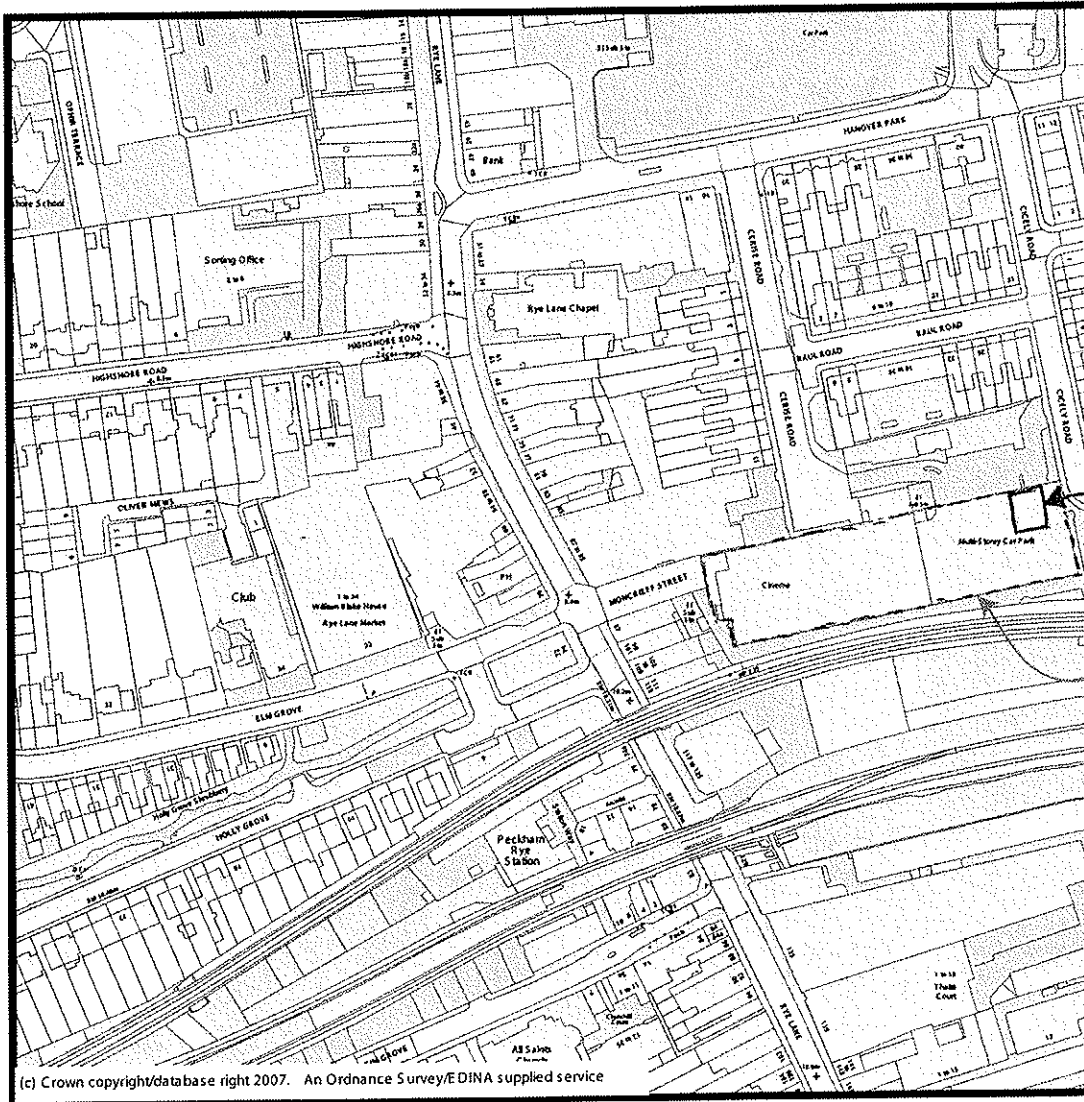
Anyone seen attempting to climb the barriers due to irresponsible or risky behaviour will be immediately stopped by a specifically designated member of staff

E) RISK OF FALLING OBJECTS

In the designated area for the consumption of drinks, a structural 'Lip' will be put in place to prevent objects such as glasses, plates or cutlery to fall off the barrier

Any items circulated on the designated premise area will not be allowed to be taken from this area and a designated member of staff will prevent clients from doing so. Furthermore, signs visible from any point in the café will make clients aware of this.

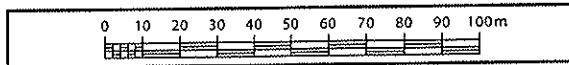
Rye Lane and carpark

Hi Jayne

Under normal circumstances, following the receipt of this E-mail and the agreement of the applicant to adopt the suggested conditions, Police would be in a position to withdraw their representations to the application.

Unfortunately, however, as stated in my earlier E-Mail, the fact that the application is for a bar venue that falls within the area of the Peckham Saturation Zone means that, in this case, Police will *not* be able to fully withdraw their representations.

The reason for this is that, by withdrawing the representations, the opportunity would then be afforded (as per the legislation) to the Licensing Unit to issue the Premises Licence as applied for

Police feel that as the venue is within the aforementioned Saturation Zone this decision should properly be made by the Licensing Committee
