Thank you for letters raising your concerns about my licence application for the Peckham Refreshment Rooms.

If I may pick up on your points of the potential disruption caused to you as local residents from rowdy and disorderly people, the resulting litter and questioning how many establishments the community needs selling alcohol selling alcohol.

Firstly , as a local resident of 10 years, myself living in Holly Grove, I want to live in a safe, clean and interesting area with a lively diverse community. The proposal for the unit is for a café/ bar that serves both food and drink. As a chef of 25 years, I feel that I can bring a new experience to my community and it will enhance the area

With reference to litter. We are not offering off license alcohol and part of the conditions will be that no bottles will leave the premises. We have hired a lockable bin to deal with rubbish to ensure that we do not litter the area.

In reference to the number of places selling alcohol, I am not sure, but I do know that we will be the only establishing serving English/ French food served with wine and beer that have been matched to the food.

Finally, we are in the process of employing 10 local people to work with us. 8 out 9 of our suppliers are based within 2 miles of Blenheim Grove. We will respect your needs as part of the community, but I feel it not appropriate to object to our application when the positives we are bringing to the area out weigh anything else.

I have attached a copy of our menu and as part of our opening will be inviting everyone on Blenheim Grove to come and share a plate of food with us. We would love it if you were part of this exciting venture
