Recommendation	That the Cabinet Member for Transport, Environment and Recycling confirms his prior verbal approval of the procurement strategy outlined in this report for the integrated parks grounds maintenance contract namely to undertake a single supplier negotiation.

That the Cabinet Member for Transport, Environment and Recycling approves the award of the integrated parks grounds maintenance contract to Quadron Services Limited in the sum of £2,659,000 for a period of one year with the option to extend by a further six months making a potential total value of £3,988,500. The award will be given effect by way of a variation to the existing contract. The new contract period will therefore run from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 or September 2015 if the additional six month option is taken.			
	3. That the Cabinet Member for Transport, Environment and Recycling approves the council entering into a Deed of Variation with Quadron Services Limited for the total contract value including paying the London Living Wage.
