## PROPOSAL

Change of use and conversion of former police station to four flats (Use Class C3) (2 one-bedroom and 1 two-bedroom and 1 three-bedroom) including the erection of rear roof extension, remodelling of elevations and the erection of a single storey side extension with roof terrace above; erection of a terrace of 5 four-bedroom houses on land to the rear facing Upland Road, each arranged over four storeys (basement, ground, first and second floor).

The sub-committee heard an introduction to the report from a planning officer, and asked questions of the planning officer.

The applicant made representations to the sub-committee and answered members' questions.
