Insert new paragraphs 1 - 4:

1. The Liberal Democrats have an ambitious vision for the future of our borough, which prioritises affordable homes, childcare and council tax. Our budget focuses on getting the basics right and achieving value for money for residents.
2. Liberal Democrat councillors have many ideas about how to encourage jobs and growth in our communities which will help boost the local economy and generate extra income for the council.
