That the Cabinet Member for Public Health, Parks & Leisure notes that the proposals within this report in conjunction with the commissioning activity outlined in paragraph 2 will deliver a programme of continuous and one off substance misuse efficiency savings against the Public Health grant between 1 April 2016 and 31 March 2019 which are anticipated to be in the region of £2 million.
