	1. Approves the extension of grant funding to currently commissioned funded arts and cultural organisations for a period of 12 months from 01 April 2017 to 31 March 2018.
	2. Approves a reduction of £100,000 of the current arts grant budget of £250,000.
	Agrees to cease one off grant funding for arts projects, totalling approximately £50,000.
	4. Agrees an overall art grant allocation to five regularly funded arts organisations of £152,000. Whilst a reduction on previous years funding, the reduction would ensure that any organisations occupying Southwark premises would still receive an amount that would enable the rent to be paid.
