	<p>To ensure all objectives are met, we have 24 hour CCTV, accredited security operatives at the property entrance/ exit and thought the premises during opening hours.</p> <p>We enforce the Challenge 21 scheme in the tap room and all of our staff are trained and familiar with using the scheme.</p> <p>We also ensure there are no hazards to harm the public or children. As per conditions of current licence.</p> <p>The bar closes 30 minutes before our licence closing time, in order to provide customers with ample time to finish their drinks before leaving.</p>

b) the prevention of crime and disorder

	<p>To prevent Crime and Disorder, we have 24 hour CCTV at the Brewery. So we always employ an additional security operatives to 'hover' throughout the premises at each event to ensure the prevention of crime and disorder. For late night events, we always have security operatives on the door and inside the building, observing and ensuring everything is in order (as per conditions of current licence).</p> <p>Customers are not allowed outside with their drinks, nor are they allowed to leave with drinks. Awarding a later licence will also contribute to a slower dissipation of customers leaving the premises throughout the evening.</p>

	<p>Ensuring public safety, we always keep our event area clean and tidy so there are no hazards to the public. Again for late night events, we have security to enforce public safety.</p> <p>The public area outside the brewery is floodlit to improve public safety in the area.</p>

d) the prevention of public nuisance

	In order to prevent public nuisance, we hold all live and recorded music events inside the Brewery. The brewery roof is insulated and there is no line of sight to local residence - therefore no residential areas are affected. The later closing time will allow guests to finish their drinks and leave at a more staggered rate throughout the evening - reducing the risk of nuisance to the public.

e) the protection of children from harm

	To protect children from harm, we ensure there are no hazards and there is no access to the area beyond our event space. We also ensure that children are accompanied by an adult at all times. Children are not permitted in the tap room beyond 9pm. We enforce the Challenge 21 scheme throughout the brewery and only use staff that are trained in the Challenge 21 scheme.
