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DETAILS OF THE REPORT

Title and brief description of the nature of the business to be considered:

Commercial Property Portfolio – Addition of Income Generating Asset

Approval is sought to the acquisition of a portfolio of a commercial property in the London Bridge area, to be held as an income generating investment and replacing income streams released in to other initiatives (regeneration etc.) in pursuit of corporate objectives.

Why has this decision been delayed until now?

The decision has been delayed until now while negotiations to acquire the asset have taken place.

Why can't the decision be reasonably deferred?

The decision cannot be reasonably deferred because the vendor has stipulated exchange of contracts and simultaneous completion in the sale/acquisition must take place as soon as possible after Cabinet's decision to proceed (assuming Cabinet is minded to do so at its meeting of 18th July 2017).

• How long has the department known the decision was to be taken?

The department has known the decision was to be taken since terms for the sale of the properties to the council were confirmed, through the issue of agreed Heads of Terms by the vendor, on 14th June 2017.

• If scheduled on the forward plan for a particular period, what's changed to make it so urgent now?

• Why is it important that this decision is taken now?

It is important that the decision is taken now in order to be able to achieve the vendors commercially driven deadline for exchange of contracts in the sale/acquisition.

• What is the potential cost to the council if the decision is delayed?

If the decision is delayed and the vendor's deadline is not met the vendor will expand its marketing of the properties and the council may lose the opportunity to secure the asset and the incomes it will provide; or it may cost more to do so.
