On weekends we will have security on the doors to help us maintain a calm and friendly atmosphere. Staff are trained in the responsible sale of alcohol like when to refuse service when someone is drunk.
 We have a strict zero-tolerance policy on drugs.

c) public safety

	All health and safety risks will be documented in risk assessments after the renovation is finished and preventative measures will be taken. For example: Full fire safety plans will be posted and accessible as well as fire extinguishers. We are also a participant in the Southwark Women's Safety Charter which is in place to help Women who encounter sexual violence on their night out, all staff are aware of this and have read the literature.
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d) the prevention of public nuisance

As stated we are willing to close the outdoor space earlier to prevent any unwanted public nuisance. Customers will then have to pass by security twice in order to exit the arches which will be preventative. We aim to work as close as possible with the local community and attend any Pub Watch meetings.
We have always played recorded music at a reasonable level and have had no complaints put to us in 4 years. We will continue to do this. Our sound system is not very powerful. On busy evenings security and staff will monitor capacity and noise level and assess situations on a case by case basis.
Rubbish will be left out of the way in large bins collected once a week to the rear of the arch way. These are not in the way of the public or residents.

e) the protection of children from harm

We operate a strict Challenge 25 policy at the bar and no children are to be allowed on site after 9PM at the weekends. No minors are allowed to be on site unsupervised.
