M - Steps to promote four licencing objectives

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (Please read guidance note 10)

1. The premises' staff will be trained to understand the responsibility attached to the supply of alcoholic drinks and that alcoholic drinks shall be limited to beer wine may be served to and consumed by persons aged 16 or 17 only if they are accompanied by persons over the age of 18 and consuming substantial food while sitting at a table.

2. No alcoholic drinks will be served to persons under 16 years of age, even when with adults, and no provision of any alcoholic drinks will be to unaccompanied persons under 18 years of age.

3. The premises shall operate an agecheck 'Challenge 25' policy whereby customers purchasing alcohol who look or appear to be under 25 years of age will be asked for an approved form of proof of age to verify their age. Approved forms shall include a driving licence, passport or a PASS approved proof of age card such as the Southwark Proof

of Age (SPA) card.

4. All staff involved in the sale of alcohol shall before doing do, receive training which will include legal requirements as to the supply of alcohol to people. This shall include training in the agecheck 'Challenge 25' policy. A record of their training, for each member of such staff shall be maintained and be available for inspection at the premises on request by the council's authorised officers or the police.

5. Agecheck or 'Challenge 25' signage shall be displayed at entrances to the premises, areas where alcohol is displayed for sale and at points of sale to inform customers that

an agecheck 'Challenge 25' policy applies and proof of age may be required.

6. A register of refused sales of alcohol sales which is clearly marked with details of the

premises, address and name of licence holder shall be maintained in order to demonstrate effective operation of the policy. The register shall be available for inspection at the premises on request by the council's authorised officers or the police. 7. The premises shall no hold licensed entertainment unless approved under a temporary events notice.

8. The premises licence holder shall display a telephone number for local residents to contact management of the premises as and when necessary.

9. No alcohol or beverages shall be taken out of the premises at any time by diners seated inside the restaurant

10. All off sales of alcohol shall be made in sealed containers and shall be for

consumption away from the premises.

11. No off sales of alcohol shall be made between the hours of 23:00 to 12:00

12. The premises may be open Monday to Saturday between 07:00 to 00:30 13. External tables and chairs will be stacked and secured in such a way as to

discourage their use after closure of the premises.

14. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system, with all entry and exit points being covered, enabling clear facial image identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensely activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days, with data and time stemping. Virging of the premiser has been described by the conditions of the premiser. with date and time stamping. Viewing of the recordings shall be made available upon the reasonable request of the Police or authorised Council officer throughout the entire 31 day period (subject to any obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998).

15. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system must be able to provide a Police or authorised Council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay. 16. The maximum external capacity will be limited to 50. 17. The external area will be out of use between 23:00 and 08:00, with all furniture having been brought into the premises or, if left outside, rendered unusable.

18. The premises will use its best endeavours to ensure that any moving of outside furniture and barriers is done in a quiet and orderly fashion. 19. Between 23:00 and 08:00, no alcoholic drinks sold or supplied by the premises shall be permitted to be consumed in the external area outside the premises. 20. After 22:00, customers permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises to smoke must be directed to stand more than 15 feet away from the 21. No external areas of the premises, including the external frontage area, shall be used for the purposes of regulated entertainment. 22. Amplified music, song or speech shall not be broadcast in external areas 23. Deliveries, collections and external cleaning shall not occur between 18:00 and 24. Any external plant such as the kitchen extraction system, condensers, etc will not operate between 00:00 - 08:00 and shall have a noise output that does not exceed 10 dB (A) below the lowest L90 15 min relevant in the period the plant will be operational. 25. All escape routes and external exits shall be maintained unobstructed, in good order with non- slippery and even surfaces, free of trip hazards and clearly identified in accordance with the approved arrangements. All exits door shall be available and easily operable without the use of a key, card, code or similar means. Any removable security fastening shall be removed from the doors prior to opening the premises to the public. All such fastenings shall be kept in the approved positions. d.lf required, exit doors shall be secured in the fully open position when the public are present. All fire-doors shall be maintained effectively self-closing and shall not be held open other than by ap proved devices. Fire-resisting doors to ducts, service shafts and cupboards shall be kept locked shut. The edges of treads of steps and stairways shall be maintained so as to be conspicuous. 26.
