My neighbour [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has forward your response below to me. For your information, I live on the flat above [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] and my bedroom [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Ubrew premises at a distance of less than 10m.

I would like to make a strong representation in support of the application submitted by [REDACTED]. Similar to episodes which [REDACTED] has noted in her application, I have witnesses and suffered from the nuisance caused by Ubrew as a result of their operation. I note that their licence is for serving alcohol to 10 pm Monday to Friday and 8 pm on weekends. The licence clearly states that outwith these hours, their patrons should not be congregating outside their premises. Practically every week during the summer months on Saturday evening, there is a significant crowd gathering outside drinking until early hours of the morning. This is because Ubrew do not have any internal place for their patrons and their only method of operation is to sell alcohol inside which are taken outside to drink particularly in the summer months when there is warmer weather and longer evenings. This practice which starts from early afternoon on Saturdays continues to early hours of Sunday morning. The noise from a crowd of people hanging around outside and involved in jovial conversation apart from being deafening but also incredibly nerve racking.

I hope you will be able to take the above declaration in your consideration of the application. If required, I shall be more than happy to elaborate on the above points.
