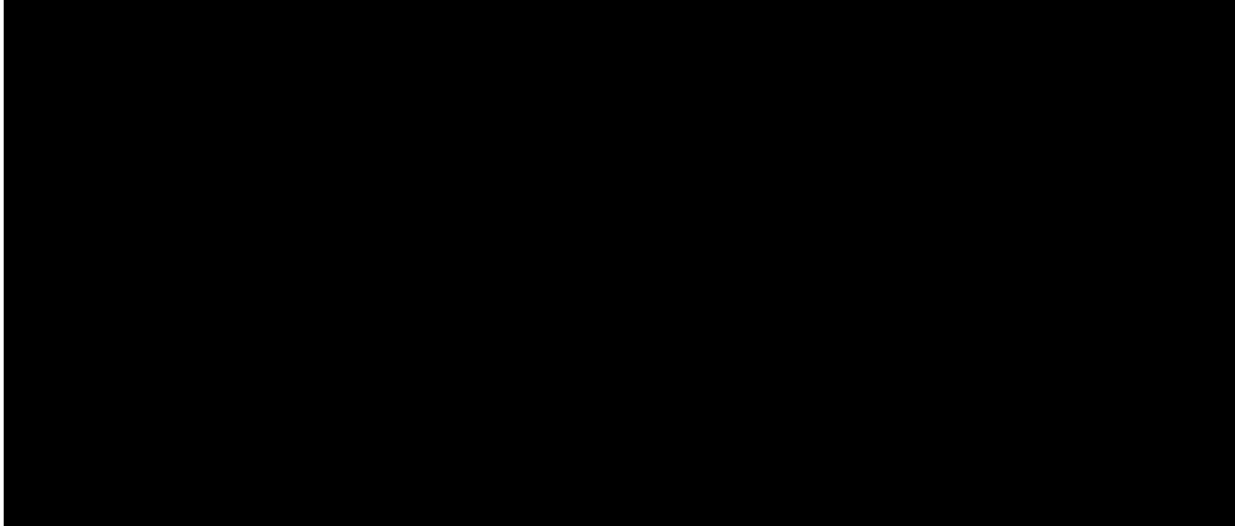

The applicant is an experienced and responsible operator and has had regard to the Licensing Act 2003, Section 182 Guidance, Southwark Statement of Licensing Policy and the need to promote the licensing objectives. The applicant notes this premises is within the Peckham CIP and offers a number of conditions to promote the licensing objectives and confirms taking these offered conditions and the nature of the operation into account there will be no risk of additional cumulative impact.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained at the premises. All recordings made by the system shall

- Be of evidential quality
- Indicate the time and date
- Be retained for a period of 28 days
- Be made available for inspection and downloading upon request to an authorised officer of a responsible authority or the licensing authority in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998. The Manager on duty will be trained in the operation of the system to ensure compliance with any such request.

2. The sale of alcohol at the premises shall only be to persons either waiting to be seated or those taking a table meal and for consumption by such persons as ancillary to their meal.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

3 . Substantial food and non-alcoholic beverages (including drinking water) shall be available throughout the hours the premises is open for licensable activities in all parts of the premises where alcohol is provided.

4. The premises will operate a "Challenge 21" policy whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 21 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age. Acceptable identification for the purposes of age verification will include a driving licence, passport or photographic identification bearing the "PASS" logo and date of birth. If the person seeking alcohol is unable to produce acceptable means of identification, no sale or supply of alcohol will be made to or for that person. Challenge 21 signage shall be displayed within the premises.

5. Each member of staff authorised to sell alcohol will receive adequate training on the law with regard to alcohol sales. All training will be properly documented and retained. The training records will be kept on the premises and made available for inspection by authorised officers.

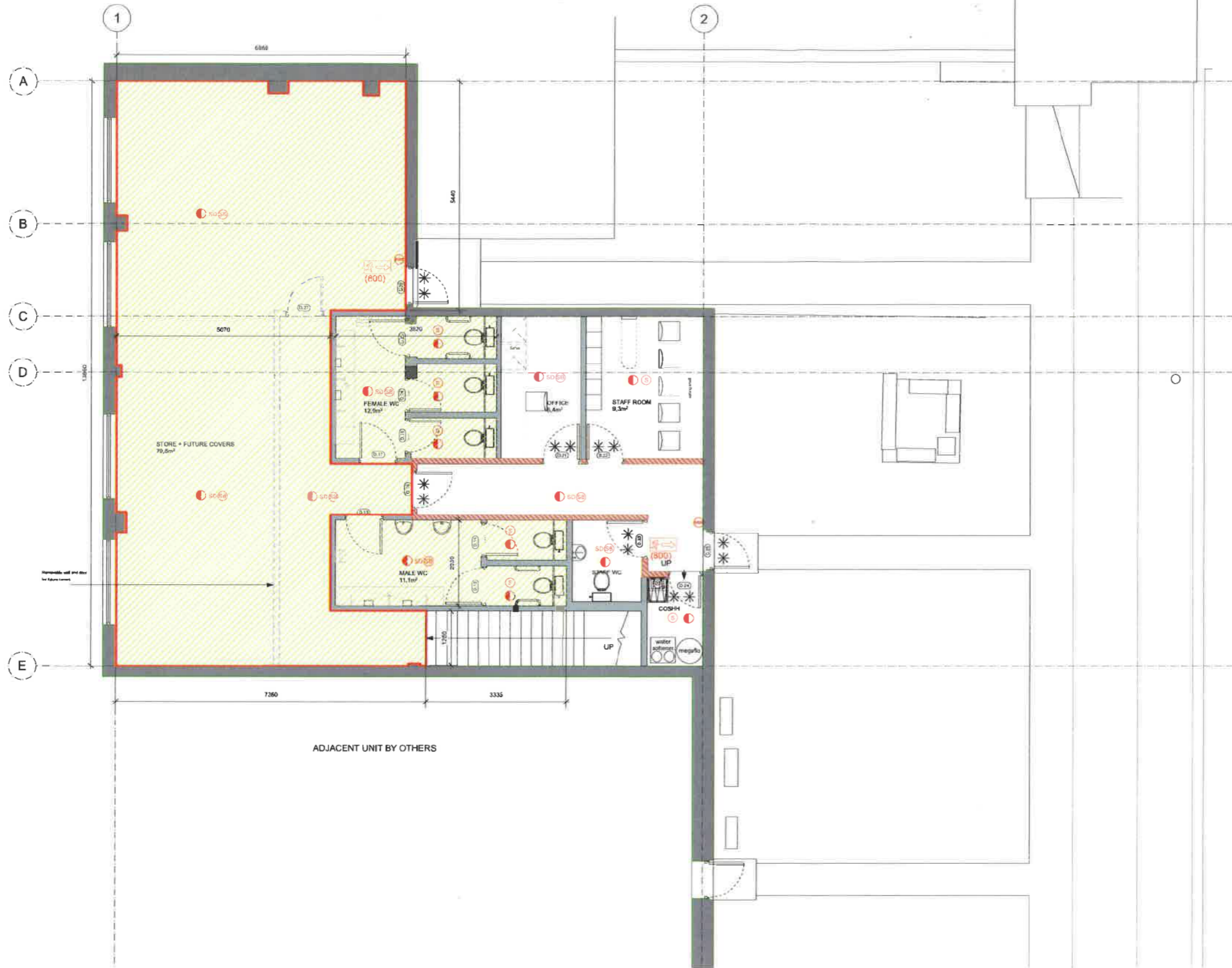

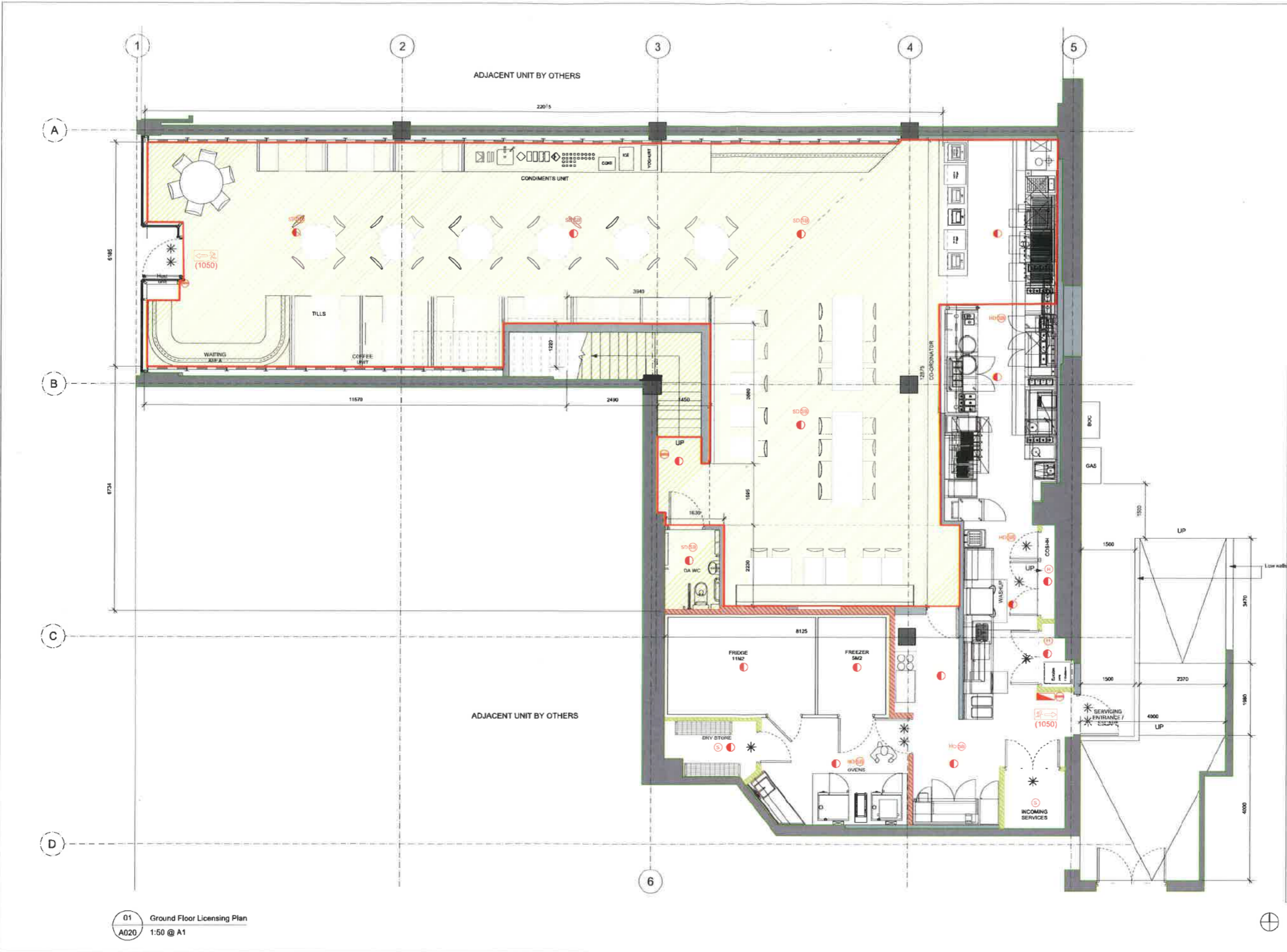
