FEEDBACK ON PUBLIC QUESTIONS RAISED AT THE LAST MEETING ON 9 DECEMBER 2009

QUESTION: What is happening to the Junction of Penrose Street and Walworth Road?

RESPONSE: Initial study of this junction confirms that there are some possible improvement options that can be done to reduce the risk of conflict between pedestrians and traffic. These options however needs to be discussed with Transport for London (TfL) to establish there viability first. Funding is always an issue that need to be resolved. Discussion with TfL is currently underway and further updates will be provided to the community council.

QUESTION: I live opposite the Heygate. My worry is about the noise and dust and traffic and waste. My son is autistic and very sensitive to noise and I worry how I am going to cope when demolition and the building work starts. What plans have been put in place to ensure that this does not affect those who neighbour the Heygate?
