That the cabinet member for community safety and health notes the recommendation to extend the contract for one year only of the two year possible extension period on the basis of the rationale stated in the 'reasons for variation' section. 3. That the cabinet member for community safety and public health notes that, should it be necessary to extend the contract for a further period not exceeding one year commencing on 4 January 2020, a further Gateway 3 variation decision report will be presented to the relevant decision-maker seeking approval to do so.
