Non-strategic Traffic and Highway improvement

A non-strategic traffic and highway improvement is a small project where the council proposes to modify the existing Highway layout. This may include changes to waiting and loading restrictions, traffic calming, improved crossing facilities etc.

Approval of origin disabled bays, subject to statutory consultation, is delegated to officers under the council's constitution. Determination of any representations is the responsibility of the Cabinet Member for Environment, Transport Management, and Air Quality.

Background / Request

- In June 2017 the council received an application for an origin disabled bay from the resident at No.42 Credon Road which was approved by the disabled travel team.
- The proposal was approved subject to statutory consultation by the Head of Highways in May 2017. The statutory consultation took place in January 2018 and 1 objection was received.
- The proposal was amended and re-advertised subject to statutory consultation by the Head of Highways in August 2018. The statutory consultation took place in January 2018 and 2 further objections were received.
