RECOMMENDATION(S)

- The recommendation is to confirm the period of the extension (which is within the maximum two year extension period detailed in the Gateway 3 – Variation Decision which was approved by Cabinet on 13 March 2018) of the current Highways and Professional Services (HAPS) contract with Conway Aecom as detailed below:
 - Lot A Highways Maintenance extend for a period of one year and three months until 30 June 2020
 - Lot B Project Delivery (Works) extend for a period of one year and three months until 30 June 2020
 - Lot C Professional Services extend for a period of one year and nine months until 31 December 2020

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2. In 2013 Southwark Council entered into a Contract with Conway Aecom Ltd for the provision of highways maintenance, project delivery (works) and associated professional services under three separate lots. This contract commenced on 1 April 2013 for an initial duration of six years, taking the initial period up to 31 March 2019, with an extension of up to two years available for use at the council's discretion. Under the terms of the contract Southwark Council need to notify Conway Aecom Ltd of any contract extension by 31 December 2018.
- 3. In accordance with the councils Contract Standing Orders a Gateway 3 Variation Decision relating to the extension of this contract was produced. This report was presented to Cabinet for determination on 13 March 2018 and the recommendations were approved.
- 4. Recommendation 1 stated "That the Cabinet approve the extension of the Highways and Professional Services (HAPS) contract with Conway Aecom Ltd from its expiry on 31 March 2019 at a cost of approximately £20m for a maximum period (subject to recommendation 2) of up to two years..."
- 5. Recommendation 2 stated "That Cabinet delegates the approval of the period of extension (within the 2 year maximum) to the Strategic Director for Environment and Social Regeneration."
- 6. Following on from that approval a Gateway 0 Strategic Options Assessment report relating to the future delivery of the highway service was prepared. This report was presented to Cabinet for determination on 24 July 2018 and those recommendations were approved. This report included recommendations to bring

- certain functions in-house whilst continuing to out-source those functions where it was beneficial to the council to do so.
- 7. These recommendations included preparing a Gateway 1 Procurement Strategy Approval for the works and services that will be outsourced. This report has been prepared and was approved at Cabinet on 11 December 2018.
- 8. This report recommended dividing the works and professional services into two separate contracts.
- 9. To ensure continuity of service it is the intention to extend Lot C Professional Services for a period of six months longer than Lot A Highway Maintenance and Lot B Project Delivery (Works). Each of these projects and schemes will have a planning and programming mobilisation period of around three months. This will ensure the new contractor for Lot B Projects will have a number of projects and schemes that they can commence as soon as their contract starts.
- 10. The works contract will be divided into two separate lots:
 - Lot A Maintenance
 - Lot B Projects

This contract would commence on 1 July 2020.

- 11. The professional services contract will be divided into three separate lots:
 - Lot A Structures Inspections and Design
 - Lot B Highways Design and Management
 - Lot C Drainage and SUDS Design and Management

This contract would commence on 1 January 2021.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 12. Under the Highways Act 1980 Southwark Council, as Highway Authority, has a duty to ensure the public highways are maintained to a safe standard. Improvements to the highways network will also help the council to achieve a number of their fairer future commitments.
- 13. To ensure these duties and commitments are met it is essential the existing service is provided until it is handed over to the provider(s) of the new contracts. Therefore, the existing HAPS contract will need to be extended until the new contracts commence.
- 14. The extension period will allow the council to undertake a vigorous and comprehensive selection and tender process for suppliers for the new contracts. The timescales have been carefully selected to ensure the tender is completed at the optimum time for the council to receive the most advantageous price and service from potential suppliers.
- 15. This contract extension will also allow the council to ensure a smooth transition for those currently out-sourced staff that will be brought in-house to carry out the functions that the Gateway 0 determined would be brought in-house. Similarly, these timescales will also allow a smooth transition of any staff that need to transfer between suppliers under TUPE regulations.

16. All risks, policy implications and considerations are detailed in the Gateway 1 – Procurement Strategy Approval for Southwark Highways Works Contracts presented to Cabinet on 11 December 2018.

Future Proposals for this Service

17. As detailed in the Gateway 3 – Variation Decision approved at Cabinet on 13 March 2018, the Gateway 0 - Strategic Options Assessment report approved at Cabinet on 24 July 2018 and the Gateway 1 - Procurement Strategy Approval for Southwark Highways Works Contracts approved (subject to call-in) at Cabinet on 11 December 2018.
