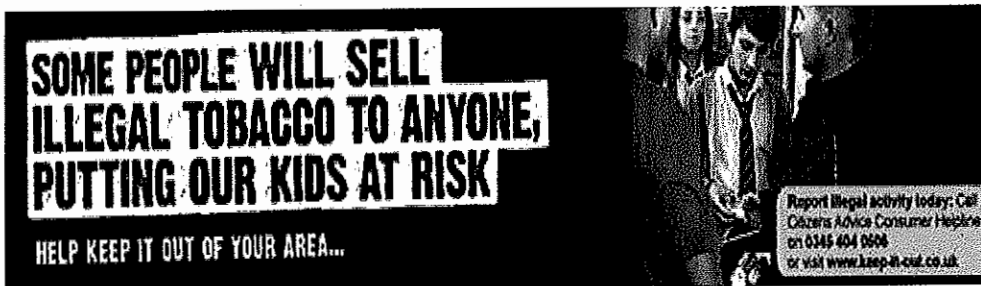

STATEMENT OF WITNESS

This statement (consisting of 2 pages) is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.

I am employed by the London Borough of Southwark as a Principal Trading Standards Officer and as such I am an authorised officer under legislation including the Licensing Act 2003. On Saturday 29th February 2020 I was conducting licensing visits accompanied by PC Maria O'MAHOMEY and Mr Adam BURCHETT, an Environmental Enforcement Officer. At about 20:00 hours we went to the premises trading as "Costa Azul" at 190-192 Old Kent Road, London, SE1 5TY. On entering the premises we announced ourselves to staff and asked to see whoever was in charge. We were directed to a lady working behind the bar who did not speak English. Another member of staff acted as translator. She gave her name as [REDACTED]. I took a brief look at the drinks products behind the bar which seemed to be largely in order. I then turned my attention to the conditions on the license and noticed the following issues.

"Condition 290- That an SIA registered door supervisor be employed in order to supervise admissions to and departures from the premises and to ensure that the premises maximum accommodation limit is not exceeded." There were no door staff present and we were told that they start at 23:00 hours.

"Condition 336- A personal license holder shall be on the premises at all times that intoxicating liquor is supplied." There was no personal license holder present. At about



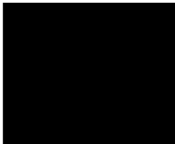
20:30 hours the Designated Premises Supervisor arrived, who is a personal license holder. That is Mr A O MENDEZ.

“Condition 342- A recognised training scheme for all the staff concerned with the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor.” The guidance given out by London Borough of Southwark trading standards was produced which has a final page where staff sign to say that they have read and understood the guidance. The names on the list did not include the lady working behind the bar and who we were originally told was in charge. Mr MENDEZ said that she had just started the previous week and had jet to be trained which is why she was not on the list. I produce this training record as an exhibit RAY/CA/1. We left the premises at approximately 20:45 hours.
