This is for a total sum of £583,779. 2. That the cabinet member for children, schools and adult care note that it is anticipated that Children's Centres will move from a grant-funded arrangement to four individual contracts from July 2020. The purpose of the three-month grant award is to allow for the formal contracting process to be completed, while allowing financial stability for Children's Centres in the interim period.


