Title of Report	Covid-19 – Post lockdown highway schemes
Description/Nature of matter requiring Key Decision	To approve a number of highway schemes across the borough that will assist social distancing and promote cycle and pedestrian safety
Decision taker	Cabinet Member for Environment, Transport and the Climate Emergency
Date by which Key Decision must be taken	June 2020
Reason why it was impracticable for decision to be on the Forward Plan	Most of the schemes were either not designed or not due for implementation for several months hence and have only become a priority due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the resultant need to social distance and promote pedestrian and cycle safety.
Reason why the decision cannot wait for inclusion in the next Forward Plan	The next Forward Plan to be published will be the July 2020 Forward Plan. The schemes are considered essential to be implemented as soon as possible. Waiting for inclusion in the next Forward Plan would ensure potential safety hazards are not addressed as soon as practicable.
