DETAILS OF THE REPORT

Southwark's Outbreak Prevention and Control Plan

It is recommended that the Cabinet Member for Community Safety and Public Health agree the Outbreak Prevention and Control Plan for Southwark dated 30 June 2020.

The draft Southwark Outbreak Prevention and Control Plan was produced through rapid cross-Council work, following direction from central government on the plans in late May. The plan has undergone discussion and challenge work across the Council to enable a robust plan to be presented at the earliest opportunity.

Local Directors of Public Health have been instructed by HM Government to establish local outbreak control plans by the end of June 2020. The draft Southwark Outbreak Prevention and Control Plan has been published and immediate implementation of the measures set out therein will limit any avoidable health impacts of future COVID-19 outbreaks within the borough.



