Public questions raised	
Q1	<p>A resident asked what they should do if they were dissatisfied with community wardens ?</p> <p>Philip Murphy (TAZ officer – Together Action Zone) said that his role was to co-ordinate so he would follow up on complaints or enquiries.</p>
Q2	<p>A resident asked about services for pensioners, disabled parking bays and accessibility.</p> <p>Cllr Capstick responded that there were facilities available such as the Southwark Park Day Centre and Spa Road. She added that regarding accessibility, the Council had looked at its buildings in terms of the Disability Discrimination Act. Some shops were still looking into this issue.</p>
Q3	<p>A resident said that in Tooley Street there was no Police station, no swimming pool and no library. They asked if there were any plans ?</p> <p>Cllr Stanton said there was no plan for a library in that area. However they often spoke of the need for better libraries and the Council would try to get a library built as part of some development.</p>
Q4	<p>A resident asked what the Council was doing to provide something positive for young people to do with their time ?</p> <p>Cllr Stanton said that half a million pounds had been invested. New facilities in Southwark Park had been provided and £300,000 of capital payments had been spent on new playgrounds. He added that some youngsters just wanted to hang out with friends and not in a bad way, just chatting or listening to music. That should be taken into consideration.</p>
