RECOMMENDATION (S)

1. It is recommended that the local parking schemes set out in the Appendix B to this report are approved for implementation subject to the outcome of any necessary statutory procedures.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2. This report presents proposals for a number of local traffic management schemes, which are matters reserved to Community councils for decision.
- 3. The origins of the proposals are indicated in the annexed schedule.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 4. The reasons for the proposed traffic schemes are set out in the Appendix B.
- 5. The proposals are consistent with the policies set out in the draft Parking and Enforcement Plan, which in turn reflects the Council's policy priorities as set out in the Community Strategy and the emerging Transport Plan.
- 6. The proposals will support the Council's Equal Opportunities Policy and will promote social inclusion:
 - By providing dedicated parking bays for people with a disability
 - By providing improved access for emergency vehicles and residents
 - Improving junction and pedestrian safety

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

7. Implementation of the proposals can be undertaken within existing budgets.

CONSULTATION

- 8. Preliminary consultation of the occupants of properties directly affected has been undertaken where appropriate.
- 9. Should the Community Council approve the item, statutory consultation will take place as part of the making of the Traffic Management Order. A proposal notice will be erected in proximity to the site location and a press notice will be published in the Southwark News and London Gazette. If there are objections the proposal, or a modified proposal will be re-submitted to the Community Council.
- 10. The Head of Transport Services (Regeneration Department) and the Head of Highways (Environment and Leisure Department) will be consulted as part of the statutory consultation.
- 11. No Consultation or comment has been sought from the Borough Solicitor & Secretary or the Chief Finance Officer.

COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT

12. The overall impact of would appear to have little impact in terms of age, disability, faith/religion, gender, race, ethnicity or sexual orientation.
