RECOMMENDATION(S)

 It is recommended that Dulwich Community Council allocates £10,000 to carry out investigation of proposals for 2007/08 Dulwich Cleaner, Greener, Safer programme.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. This report presents proposals related to Dulwich 2007/08 Cleaner, Greener, Safer programme, which is a matter reserved to Dulwich Community Council for decision.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3. The proposal is to allocate £10,000 to allow the Project Team in the Public Realm Division to commission investigations on selected applications to 2007/08 Dulwich Cleaner, Greener, Safer programme.
- 4. The approved amount will be a provision to allow more accurate costings and scope of work to be determined at the feasibility stage of assessing individual proposals. It is estimated this would affect a small number of proposals and the majority of feasibility assessments will be carried out within the Project Team and not draw on this allocation.
- 5. For example, the money could be spent on the following types of works:
 - Surveyor's fees for inspecting and producing estimates for repair works (eg Sea Cadets Hall, North Dulwich Tennis Club)
 - Site investigations on ball court areas to allow accurate costs to be provided for works / costed options to be available for members (eg East Dulwich Community Centre ball court resurfacing).
 - Highway Engineer's fees for providing costed options for works to roads and pathways (eg Spurling Road safety works)
 - Specialist advice on areas such as drainage, topographical and basement surveys (eg Lordship Lane shopping parade, East Dulwich Community Centre).
- 6. The results of investigations will be included in feasibility assessments and reported back to Dulwich Community Council.

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

7. Implementation of the proposal can be undertaken within 2007/08 Dulwich Cleaner, Greener, Safer budget.

CONSULTATION

- 8. Consultation has not been carried out on this proposal.
- 9. No consultation or comment has been sought from the Borough Solicitor and Secretary or the Chief Finance Officer.
