Insert new recommendations 2, 3 and 4 as below:

2. Council notes that there are a small number of important issues which have been omitted from the current draft of the Corporate Plan 2009-11 as they remain under review at the current time, including specifically:
 - a) Road safety targets, which are currently being reviewed through the refresh of the road safety strategy
 - b) Primary school provision in the Dulwich area, which is currently subject to discussions with the governors of the existing schools
 - c) Energy efficiency in homes, which is currently the subject of a new Energy efficiency contract which is being procured by the environment and housing department
 - d) Increasing the use of online transactions, which is currently being examined as part of the review of customer service strategy.
3. Council notes that in paragraph 4 of the report, it states: “The performance elements of the plan are being finalised in line with the local area agreement refresh and top tier indicators will be kept under review to ensure that the corporate plan remains relevant.”
4. Council therefore calls on the executive, at the next review of the corporate plan, to look at whether these issues can be incorporated into the relevant sections of the plan.
