- 1. What is the review?
- 2. What outcomes could realistically be achieved? Who does the committee want to influence?
- 3. What does the committee aim to produce?
- 4. What are some of the key issues that you'd like to look at during the review?
- 5. Who would you like to receive evidence and advice from during the review?
- 6. Any suggestions for background information? Are you aware of any best practice on this topic?
- 7. What approaches could be useful for gathering evidence? What can be done outside committee meetings? e.g. verbal or written submissions, site visits, mystery-shopping, service observation, meeting with stakeholders, survey, consultation event or additional public meetings
- 8. When should the review be carried out/completed? i.e. does the review need to take place before/after a certain time?
- 9. How much formal committee meeting time do you want to commit to this topic?
