 - (a) Borough & Bankside (Comprising Cathedrals and Chaucer Wards
 - (b) Bermondsey (Comprising Grange, Riverside and South Bermondsey Wards)
 - (c) Rotherhithe (Comprising Rotherhithe and Surrey Docks Wards. Livesey Ward,north of the Old Kent Road)
 - (d) Walworth (Comprising East Walworth, Faraday and Newington Wards)
 - (e) Peckham (Comprising Peckham Ward. Livesey Ward, south of the Old Kent Road)
 - (f) Camberwell (Comprising Brunswick Park, Camberwell Green and South Camberwell Wards)
 - (g) Nunhead & Peckham Rye (Comprising Nunhead, Peckham Rye and The Lane Wards)
 - (h) Dulwich (Comprising College, East Dulwich and Village Wards)
- 2. That Chairs/Vice-Chairs of the Community Councils be appointed for the remainder of the Municipal Year 2002/2003 to serve until the Constitutional Council in May 2003.

(<u>NOTE</u>: These appointments are subject to Council Assembly's decision in the report entitled 'Constitutional Issues - Community Councils' which will consider the options for the appointments of Chairs and Vice-Chairs).

3. That the Membership of the eight Community Councils, as indicated in Appendix 2, be noted.

(<u>NOTE</u>: If Option 2 in the 'Constitutional Issues - Community Councils' report is agreed then Council Assembly will appoint the Membership.)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 4. On 27th November 2002, Council Assembly agreed a policy on area decision-making and the establishment of Community Councils. Following consideration of the report earlier in this Agenda entitled 'Constitutional Issues Community Councils', this report seeks to formally constitute the Councils and provides Council Assembly with the opportunity to appoint Chairs and Vice-Chairs. Consequent changes to the Constitution are included in that earlier report on this Agenda.
- 5. Community Councils do not need to be politically balanced. In addition Community Councils can only include members of the local authority who are members for the electoral wards wholly or partly contained within the area for which the committee has functions. The pool of Members able to serve on Community Councils is set out in Appendix 2.
