2. QUESTION FROM MR ABDUR RAZAQ SALAWU TO THE EXECUTIVE MEMBER FOR REGENERATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Old Kent Road Mosque and Cultural Centre, which provides such valuable services in Southwark, is facing a serious congestion problem. Can the council help by donating the piece of land at the junction of Glengall Road and Old Kent Road for the construction of a more spacious cultural centre?

3. QUESTION FROM MR M. AJIBIKE TO THE EXECUTIVE MEMBER FOR REGENERATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

A large number of people worship at the Old Kent Road Mosque and Cultural Centre especially on Fridays, so worshippers spill over to the grounds of the estate and roads adjacent to the centre, thus causing problems with neighbours and the traffic. What alternative accommodation can the council provide?
