RECOMMENDATIONS

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The council appoints representatives to serve on the LGA Urban Commission on an annual basis. The appointment of representatives to the LGA Urban Commission falls within the terms of reference of the executive. However, the closing date for notifying the LGA of the council's appointments is Friday June 23 2006 and there is not an executive meeting scheduled to meet before that date, council assembly is therefore being asked to agree the appointments for 2006/2007 in order to meet the deadline set by the LGA.

REASONS FOR URGENCY AND LATENESS

- It was intended that the appointment of representatives to the LGA Urban Commission be considered at the first meeting of the executive, which was scheduled for June 21. However, it became apparent after the council assembly agenda despatch (hence the reason for lateness) that the executive would not be able to meet on the date scheduled due to a 'Staff Awards' event taking place on that evening for which chief officers and some members would be attending.
- 8. It is not practicable for the first meeting of the executive to take place before the week beginning June 26, the deadline for informing the LGA of the council's appointed

representatives will therefore not be met unless considered at this council assembly meeting.
