It will be impossible for us to make a profit or even break even on these figures. There is grave concern as to who is managing at LEA level the kitchen repairs/maintenance budget? Who do schools turn to for advice etc. on this specialist area? Redundancies have been made with no information as to who will be the named officer responsible.

Governor, Special School

The structure is not in place for a smooth transition of contract. Provision will need to be set in place for special diets and needs of students.

Governor and Bursar, Special School

There are serious concerns regarding repairs and maintenance as we would not be taking over a well maintained property to start with. Little updates have taken place over the past years and the school could be placed in a seriously difficult position regarding Health and Safety. Also our investigations into the cost of meals, suggests they would rise considerably putting them beyond the means of parents. Urgent detailed advice is needed from the education department.
