

## Summary of actions

---

### Phase 1: 2003/04 – 2005/06

- develop promotional and advisory material for recyclables for householders
- develop a waste minimisation strategy and introduce a waste minimisation programme
- conduct a seasonal waste audit
- expand kerbside to the whole of Southwark for just paper
- expand kerbside to the whole of Southwark and include other materials (paper and card, cans, glass)
- introduce estate recycling collections
- rationalise and consolidate existing bank system to ensure optimum coverage
- use the existing bulking facilities at Manor Place
- provide compost bins to houses with gardens
- provide skips for garden waste at the Manor Place CA site, if appropriate
- reorganise the existing CA facilities at Manor Place
- provide a green waste kerbside collection service
- re-site the CA site facilities at Manor Place
- link up with the community sector for re-use and recycling of bulky waste
- include recycling outputs and investment requirements in a new waste management contract.
- Green procurement

### Phase 2: 2007 - 10

- modify and improve the promotional material
- full coverage of recycling systems following evaluation and modification
- undertake a seasonal waste audit
- expand scope of estate-based kerbside
- establish new waste management facilities in or close to the borough
- provide facilities for the re-use and recycling of white goods, timber, IT, office and household furniture
- evaluate the operation of the disposal and collection contract (s).

**Phase 3: 2011 - 21**

- modify and improve on the kerbside, bring and CA site systems
- evaluate the operation of the disposal and collection contract (s).
