

London and the South East Region Results

Summary

Each trust is given a rating for quality of services and a rating for use of resources.

The results for the south east region show:

- forty three trusts (36%) rated "excellent" or "good" for quality of services, with five (four per cent of the total) getting the higher rating
- fifteen trusts (12%) rated as "excellent" or "good" for use of resources, with four (three per cent of the total) getting the higher rating.

But:

- sixty six trusts (55%) scored "fair" for quality of services
- eleven trusts (9%) scored "weak" for quality of services
- fifty eight trusts (48%) scored "fair" for use of resources
- forty seven trusts (39%) scored "weak" for use of resources.

Trusts performing particularly well in the London and south east region included the Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust. This was one of only two trusts in the country to score "excellent" on both quality of services and use of resources.

Regional comparisons

For quality of services results show:

- the central region has the highest percentage of organisations receiving a score of excellent or good
- the central region has the lowest percentage of organisations receiving a score of weak.
- the poorest performing region was the south west, with 15% of trusts receiving a score of weak

For use of resources results show:

- the north has performed better than the regions, with 25% of trusts receiving a score of excellent or good
- the north region has the highest number of foundation trusts. Foundation trusts have generally performed better for both use of resources and quality of services.
