RECOMMENDATION:

1. That Housing Scrutiny Sub-Committee consider the attached draft report entitled "Private Housing Renewal Policy" prior to its consideration by the Executive on 8th July 2003. A key aspect of the proposed policy relates to arrangements for loan finance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- 2. The attached report to the Executive sets out proposed changes to Council policy in respect of private sector housing renewal. The Regulatory Reform Order will come into force on 18th July 2003 and gives the authority a general power to offer assistance to qualifying persons for a variety of purposes, and the opportunity to devise its own means by which to assist with housing repair, improvement or adaptation works.
- 3. In order to exercise its powers under the order, Southwark must adopt a policy for assistance [and give public notice of the adoption of such a policy], and make a full policy document available for inspection on request and by post by the 18th July 2003. This order repeals the Housing Grants Construction and Regeneration Act (1996) and failure to adopt a policy by this deadline date would render the authority without a policy and hence the legal power to provide assistance.

4. The detail of the proposals are set out in full in Appendices 1 & 2 to the attached draft Executive report, and its key priorities and guiding principles summarised in paragraphs 4 & 5 of that report.
