RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. That Overview and Scrutiny Committee (OSC) endorse the findings and recommendations from the review of delivery arrangements for recycling initiatives undertaken by the Environment & Transport Scrutiny Sub Committee, as outlined in the substantive, earlier report already provided to the Committee but in the light of indicative figures now provided by officers below, namely;
- 2. That having considered the indicative figures provided in this supplemental report (section 6 below), OSC recommend to the Executive that an additional 10%-15% of the revenue budget for delivery on recycling arrangements during 2003/04 should be made available for a comprehensive programme of publicity, education and information.

BACKGROUND

- Officers have provided an earlier report to OSC on the findings of a review of recycling arrangements across the borough, with particular reference to encouraging and promoting the take up of recycling facilities on the part of residents.
- 4. OSC are asked to endorse a recommendation that 10%-15% of the revenue budget for delivery on recycling arrangements in 2003/04 be made available for a comprehensive programme of publicity, education and information about recycling provision in the borough, with particular reference to the take up of the Blue Box Scheme.
- 5. At the time of writing the original report indicative figures were not available to enable members to judge what an increase of 10%-15% on the revenue budget might amount to. These figures are given below.
- 6. At the Executive meeting on 17th December 2002, it was resolved, in principle, that £346,000 be included in the 2003/04 revenue budget for Estate Based Recycling. This is the only recycling growth bid. 10%-15% of this would be £34,600 £51,900. In addition, the current recycling budget is £500,000. 10%-15% of this figure is £50,000 £75,000.
