<p>Scrutiny Project Brief for:</p> <p>REVIEW OF THAMES WATER'S RESPONSE TO FAILURE OF WATER SUPPLY IN SOUTHWARK</p>
<p>Date(s) of consideration: 13 October, 10 November</p>
<p>Why is the Committee doing this?</p> <p>Responding to public concern over Thames Water's arrangements in the event of a major supply failure. Issues are: the logistical arrangements at the time of the failure, information to the public and other agencies, and compensation</p>
<p>Who/what does the Committee seek to influence with this work?</p> <p>Thames Water in first instance. Also need to explore whether there is useful learning that can be fed into London Resilience</p>
<p>What will the Committee's output be?</p> <p>A submission to Thames Water (and possibly to London Resilience if the review raises significant issues)</p>
<p>Who does the Sub-Committee need to receive advice/evidence from?</p> <p>Members of the public who were affected (individuals/businesses/other organisations) Thames Water Possibly Southwark officers who were in liaison with Thames Water</p>
<p>What approach should the Sub-Committee use to invite input? E.g. site visit, meeting stakeholders, survey, holding meetings in relevant venues</p>
<p>How should the review be publicised? E.g. website, Southwark Life, via community council agendas, community groups</p>
