The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the end of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason

The proposed lighting shall be set to an appropriate time control, and the illumination shall be switched off each evening at midnight, and not switched on again until, as required, the following evening.

Prior to the commencement of the lighting installation works full details of the proposed luminescence shall be submitted to the local planning authority, and the equipment shall not be operated until the details have been given prior written approval.
