1. What is the review?

Review of the provision and management of sports facilities in Peckham Rye Park.

2. What outcomes could realistically be achieved? Which agency does the review seek to influence?

The review should seek to achieve an understanding of the current management arrangements for the sports facilities in Peckham Rye and of how these are perceived by users of the facilities. The review should seek to make recommendations for improving the management to enable greater and more efficient use of the facilities. It should also seek to make recommendations on how future developments of sporting and other leisure facilities in the borough can be better tailored to meet the needs of local communities and groups.

3. When should the review be carried out/completed?

This should be a short review, with the meeting scheduled at a time when community attendance can be maximised.

4. What format would suit this review?

A one-off session with evidence from a relevant officer and users of the facilities.

5. What are some of the key issues that you would like the review to look at?

- To what extent were users and local communities consulted on the replacement sporting facilities provided at Peckham Rye and how was this consultation fed into final decisions?
- How effective has the management of the facilities, including the booking system, been since their opening? Have the management processes contributed or detracted from the fullest possible use of the facilities?
- Is there an effective process in place to resolve disputes/complaints between users and council officers regarding use of the facilities? What structures could be put in place to prevent such disputes arising?
- What lessons can be learnt from the experience in Peckham Rye to ensure that the future provision of sporting facilities across the borough reflects the wishes of user groups?

6. Who would you like to receive evidence and advice from during the review?

Head of Culture, Libraries, Learning and Leisure, representatives of user groups, including Southwark Carrib football club.

7. Any suggestions for background information? Are you aware of any best practice on this topic?

A briefing paper on the management procedures for the facilities should be provided prior to the meeting.

8. What approaches could be useful for gathering evidence? What can be done outside committee meetings?

All regular users of the facilities should be invited to provide either written or oral evidence to the review. Notices inviting this should be displayed at Peckham Rye.
