1) Response to whether the CGS agenda includes improving signage to the hospitals from Peckham:

"Cleaner Greener Safer's (CGS) scheme to improve signage in Camberwell does not include the Peckham area. It is focused on Denmark Hill, Camberwell New Road, Camberwell Church Street and Camberwell Road. I would advise whoever wants this to happen to speak to someone at transport planning, maybe Barbara Selby and then look at where funding could be sourced from. It could be as with the Camberwell Signage scheme, a CGS scheme."

2) Further information about work recommencing on the Elmington Estate from Maurice Soden, the Regeneration and Initiatives Manager for Environment and Housing:

Leading on from my previous report at the Camberwell scrutiny committee September 3 2008:

The process of selecting partners for the disposal and working through design and planning would then follow; it should be expected that it would take a further 9-12 months for a developer to start construction work on site. Development will go ahead as we cannot countenance leaving the sites vacant indefinitely. About 12 months is my best estimate, but there are some fairly complex issues to solve and the obvious impact of the uncertain housing market and shortage of private development finance.
