## RECOMMENDATION

1. That council assembly consider the following information on proposal F / permaculture in conjunction with the report on the main agenda.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

2. As set out in the report on the main agenda (appendix 1), the panel recommended proposal F 'permaculture design principles' for submission (although not by consensus) but subject to getting views from officers on how to make workable. This addendum report provides that additional information.

#### **KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION**

- 3. The proposal from the panel is: **Permaculture design principles** A permissive regime that enables Council to prioritise permaculture<sup>1</sup> design principle in local planning policy.
- 4. Developers are currently required to provide outside amenity space, but how people use that is up to them (it could be, for example, food production or play space).
- 5. The advice from officers is that the best 'workable' way of achieving the aims of the proposal is through national policy guidance that would:
  - require developers to consider the needs of permaculture in the design of amenity of space (e.g. that the land would need to be free from contamination)
  - guide local planning authorities on what they should be looking for
- 6. Policy, community and resource implications:

<u>Policy implications</u>: there would be social and health advantages of people being involved in food production, which would support the delivery of our Corporate Plan priorities and Southwark 2016.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The meaning of 'permaculture': promoting design that increases sustainability and self sufficiency of food supply and production within a wider context – recognising the overriding importance of food.

<u>Community impact</u>: there will be competing demands on amenity open space, so if there is a demand for the space to be used for permaculture there may be less space for other priorities.

Resource implications: training of staff to implement it.

#### **REASONS FOR URGENCY**

8. The deadline for submitting proposals to the Local Government Association is the 31 July 2009, this matter cannot wait for a further meeting to be held, the consequences of a delay would be that the proposal could not be submitted.

#### **REASONS FOR LATENESS**

9. This additional information is late due to the complexity of the proposal and the need to consult with the proposer.
