Detailed drawings and manufacturers specifications of the replacement windows including elevations and sections (scale 1:50) shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority before any work in connection with this permission is carried out, and the development shall not be carried out otherwise than in accordance with any such approval given.

Reason

In the interests of the visual amenities of the building and the setting of an adjacent listed building, in accordance with Policies: 3.11 Efficient use of land; 3.12 Quality in Design; 3.13 Urban Design; and 3.18 Setting of listed buildings, conservation areas and world heritage sites of The Southwark Plan (UDP) July 2007

- 6 Additional information:

The applicant has advised that if permission is granted, work would commence in April / May this year, and would take approximately 55 weeks to complete.
