### RECOMMENDATION

1. That cabinet considers whether or not to hear deputations from:
  - Dog owners in Southwark
  - Friends of Nunhead Cemetery
  - Home care workers.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. When considering whether to hear the deputation request, cabinet can decide
  - To receive the deputation at this meeting or a future meeting; or
  - That the deputation not be received; or
  - To refer the deputation to the most appropriate committee/sub-committee.
3. A deputation shall consist of no more than six people, including its spokesperson. Only one member of the deputation shall be allowed to address the meeting for no longer than five minutes. After this time cabinet members may ask questions of the deputation for up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the questions, the deputation will be shown to the public area where they may listen to the remainder of the open section of the meeting.

### KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4. The deadline for receipt of deputation requests for this cabinet meeting was Midnight 25 October 2017. The requests were received in line with this constitutional deadline.

### Deputation requests

#### On behalf of dog owners in Southwark

5. A deputation request has been submitted on behalf of dog owners in Southwark in respect of the introduction of public space protection orders to tackle dog related anti-social behaviour. The deputation wish to address cabinet about the process surrounding the recently proposed Public Space Protection Orders (PSPOs), the restrictions on dog owners and the approach taken to gaining new powers. The deputation wish to outline the impact of the consultation process and express their views on the process.

### Friends of Nunhead Cemetery

6. The deputation would like to make the case for restrictions on dogs in Nunhead Cemetery over and above those recommended by officers in the report relating to the introduction of Public Space Protection Orders (PSPOs) on the cabinet agenda.

### Home care workers

7. The deputation would like to address cabinet on the home care report, cross referencing with the fairer futures procurement strategy and trade union recognition.

### Community impact statement

8. The Southwark Constitution allows for deputations to be made by groups of people resident or working in the borough.
