RECOMMENDATION

1. That cabinet considers whether or not to hear deputation requests from:
 - Bankside Busking Working Group
 - Southwark Homeowners Council

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. When considering whether to hear the deputation request, cabinet can decide
 - To receive the deputation at this meeting or a future meeting; or
 - That the deputation not be received; or
 - To refer the deputation to the most appropriate committee/sub-committee.
3. A deputation shall consist of no more than six people, including its spokesperson. Only one member of the deputation shall be allowed to address the meeting for no longer than five minutes. After this time cabinet members may ask questions of the deputation for up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the questions, the deputation will be shown to the public area where they may listen to the remainder of the open section of the meeting.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4. The deadline for receipt of deputation requests for this cabinet meeting was midnight Wednesday 20 June 2018. The requests were received in line with this constitutional deadline.

Bankside Busking Working Group

5. A deputation request has been submitted by the Bankside Busking working group to address cabinet in respect of item 16: Motions from council assembly (busking on Bankside).
6. The deputation wish to present to cabinet the Bankside Busking Strategy drafted by the Working Group and for cabinet to consider the short, medium and long term recommendations with a view to progressing them.

Southwark Homeowners Council

7. A deputation request has been submitted by Southwark Homeowners Council in respect of Item 11: Response to housing and community safety scrutiny sub-committee review of resident engagement.
8. The deputation are of the view that the report does not reflect the current position in relation to Homeowners Council as it is based on information from last year and is representative of the position at that time. The deputation wish to provide the cabinet with up to date information and relevant background prior to cabinet making a decision.

RECOMMENDATION

1. That the cabinet nominate Councillor Stephanie Cryan, cabinet member for housing management and modernisation as the Southwark representative on the Greater London Employment Forum for the 2018-19 municipal year.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. Council Assembly agreed nominations to London Councils Committees, Greater London Employment Forum, Borough Lead Members and London Councils Limited for the 2018-19 municipal year at the annual meeting of council assembly held on 21 May 2018.
3. As part of the nominations process Councillor Kieron Williams, cabinet member for jobs, skills and innovation was agreed as the nomination to Greater London Employment Forum. It has since been realised that the nomination should have been Councillor Stephanie Cryan, cabinet member with responsibility for 'human resources' of which the Greater London Employment Forum is concerned with.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4. The nomination of representatives to the London Councils committees and forums fall within the remit of the cabinet. However council assembly was asked to agree the nominations as the deadline for submission of nominations to London Councils was 31 May 2018, which was before the first meeting of Cabinet.
5. The purpose of the Greater London Employment Forum is to provide a forum where London employer and employee representatives can meet to discuss and debate employment matters of concern to the London authorities and their workforces and, where appropriate, recommend areas/opportunities for regional agreement and working.
