RECOMMENDATION

1. That cabinet considers whether or not to hear deputation requests from:
 - Ledbury Residents Project Group (RPG)
 - The Tustin Community Association and
 - Extinction Rebellion Southwark.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. When considering whether to hear the deputation request, cabinet can decide:
 - To receive the deputation at this meeting or a future meeting; or
 - That the deputation not be received (if the matter is not dealt with by cabinet, the matter shall be referred without debate to the relevant cabinet member who shall after consideration, respond with an open reply to the sender); or
 - To refer the deputation to the most appropriate committee/sub-committee.
3. A deputation shall consist of no more than six people, including its spokesperson. Only one member of the deputation shall be allowed to address the meeting for no longer than five minutes. After this time cabinet members may ask questions of the deputation for up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the questions, the deputation will be shown to the public area where they may listen to the remainder of the open section of the meeting.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4. The deadline for receipt of deputation requests for this cabinet meeting was midnight 7 July 2021. These requests were received within this constitutional deadline.

Deputation requests

Ledbury Residents Project Group (RPG)

- The Ledbury Resident Project Group (RPG) would like to present a deputation to inform cabinet on the progress made in working with residents to identify the option to replace the existing Ledbury Towers, how residents have been involved in this, and Ledbury Residents', and those with the right to return and aspirations for a the future of Ledbury Towers.

The Tustin Community Association

- The Tustin Community Association would like to address cabinet to inform about the progress made, from a residents' point of view, in securing a future for the estate that will improve the housing, school, commercial units and other public spaces on Tustin, and set out a process supported by residents to reach that goal. The deputation will update the cabinet on the work of residents and others to secure a lasting legacy from the regeneration proposals.

Extinction Rebellion Southwark

- Extinction Rebellion Southwark wish to address cabinet in respect of the climate strategy report on the cabinet agenda to highlight a number of concerns relating to progress, identifiable and measurable targets and the need to address all the areas relating to household consumption, business practice, what is developed and movement around the Borough. Extinction Rebellion Southwark have argued that radical action is required to get a net-zero emissions by 2030.

Community impact statement

- The Southwark Constitution allows deputations to be made by groups of people resident or working in the borough.
